Professor Robert Flynn works as a consultant Urologist in AMNCH Tallaght University Hospital, a teaching hospital for Trinity College Dublin. He is also the Urologist attached to the National Rehabilitation Hospital in Dublin.

Robert Flynn graduated from Trinity College Dublin, and was

trained in the field of Urology in Dublin, London and Cardiff. He was a consultant in Wales from 2000 to 2005 before returning to Dublin as a consultant Urologist at the Tallaght Hospital and the National Rehabilitation Hospital, Dun Laoghaire in 2005. He commenced practice in the Beacon Hospital in 2006.

His academic achievements include over 20 peer-reviewed publications. He is a Clinical Senior Lecturer at TCD, the Training Programme Director in Urology for Ireland, and an Intercollegiate FRCS (Urol) examiner since 2008 to date.
